26 Fincas de Azabache Tempranillo Blanco <i>Spain</i> This is a real find. White Tempranillo is a ..new% grape variety but closely linked to the well known red Tempranillo grown all over Spain. This style is robust yet unoaked, with apple refreshment and elegantly balanced. (1)	£32.50
27 Paola Sordo Gavi <i>Italy</i> A wine with a pale, straw-yellow gleam, this Gavi offers delicate flower and fruit sensations with notes of linden blossom and peach. On the palate the wine is subtle, elegant and refined. Crisp and zesty, with a balanced and lingering finish. (1)	£37.50
28 Secret Viognier Viu Manent <i>Chile</i> Intense golden yellow with greenish nuances and tremendous brilliance. 37 Chablis 1er Cru Les Vaudevay Domaine Laroche <i>France</i> The elegant biscuit and brioche aroma is fitting of its ..Premier Cru% status. Fine fruit flavour with the merest hint of oak to round out the citrus notes and extend the finish. (2)	£82.00
38 Condrieu E. Guigal <i>France</i> Three great words: Condrieu (the place) - Viognier (the grape) - Guigal (the producer) - show why the pulses race. Here is an elegantly-matured classic to match its reputation. (2)	£90.00

43 Côtes du Rhône Rouge Colombo & Fille <i>France</i> A bright and seductively fruity wine packed with red fruit characters, well-rounded tannins and balanced acidity. (C)	£38.00
44 Chateau La Pointe Bouquey <i>France</i> Just as a Bordeaux should be, smooth, expressive with a juicy soft texture. A fruity combination of blackcurrant and blueberries all held together with an abundance of silky tannins. (C)	£39.00

50 Ermita de San Felices Reserva <i>Spain</i> Intensely concentrated with blackberry fruit and wonderful enriching sweetness. Beginning to show meaty, gamey, leathery development with a finish that lasts forever. Fabulous! (D)	£48.00
51 Morgon Les Corcelettes Louis Latour <i>France</i> Morgon is the most dense and long-lived Cru of Beaujolais. Full-bodied, firm and able to age. (D)	£50.00
52 Amarone della Valpolicella Zonin <i>Italy</i> Intense colour leads into an inviting bouquet of wild hedgerow berries. There is a velvety feel and masses of rich sun-dried fruit, spice and integrated balanced tannins. (E)	£75.00
53 Rocca di Montemassi <i>Italy</i> This superb Tuscan is ruby red with garnet reflections. Complex aromas showing cherry, plum and currant with notes of violet, eucalyptus, vanilla and sweet tobacco. A rich and elegant palate of fresh fruit showing spicy toasted notes. (D)	£80.00
54 Chateau Musar <i>Lebanon</i> Blood red in colour with a rich, fragrant fruit nose; mulberries, black cherries, plums with a hint of mocha. The palate is very intense and concentrated, it's full of volume and characterised by forest and black fruits with elegant spice. The tannins are soft and juicy and it has a lengthy finish. (D)	£85.00
55 Château Potensac <i>France</i> Classic notes of red and blackcurrants, earth and spice are well-presented in this deep ruby/purple coloured, medium-bodied wine, which should drink nicely for a decade or more. (C)	£85.00
56 Gevrey-Chambertin Domaine Chanson <i>France</i> Very refreshing aromas of red berries mixed with spices and vanilla. Well-integrated notes of oak and a refined tannic structure. (C)	£120.00
57 Château Léoville-Las-Cases 2ème Cru Classé <i>France</i> Very dark in colour with black edges leading to brick red. It has a cool and intensely concentrated fruit aroma with a powerful finish. (D)	£275.00
